**Literacy**

**Fiction:** We will explore the story - 'The Twits' - by Roald Dahl. The children will describe Mr & Mrs Twit using a range of description techniques.

**Non-Fiction:** Linked to 'The Twits', the children will write REVOLTING RECIPES. To do this, they will explore instructional writing and understand the different features of this genre.

**Homework:** Remember to complete your weekly reading homework as well as practising the spellings in the back of your homework book.



**History: Spring Gardens Primary School**

This unit is all about SGPS!  
We will explore the history of our school and think about how our school has changed over time.



**Music**

We will continue learning notes B, A and G on the recorder. We will also sing and explore a song called 'Bringing Us Together'.



**Art: Telling Stories Through Drawing and Making**

We will explore characters from film and literature, particularly looking at the work of Roald Dahl and Quentin Blake. We will use our sketchbooks to respond to word / film and then make a sculptural character.

**PSHE: Money Matters**

We will look at the beauty of repeating patterns in nature and different methods of recreating these with digital art tools and photo editing.
