Catch up Funding Planned Expenditure Spring Gardens Primary School

Following the 2020 lockdown due to the COVID-19 pandemic, schools have received an additional amount of money to provide catch-up support for those pupils that require it. At Spring Gardens Primary, in order to utilise this funding in the best possible way we have carefully considered the individual needs of our children and families from both an academic and personal perspective. EEF recommendations have informed decision making.
