

Sleeping Arrangements

- · Dormitories are heated, have toilets and call buttons for emergencies
- · There are separate dormitories for boys and girls
- Dormitories sleep 4 12 children in bunk beds
- · We receive the dormitory numbers / layouts just before the trip and therefore do not tell the children until arrival they will be with a friend!
- Please let us know of any issues your child may have around bed time If they have a favourite teddy then they are welcome to bring it but have their name on it!
- ·If your child has accidents in the night then please make sure we are aware
- The very supportive and fantastic Robinwood staff are on duty throughout the night and in constant contact with group leader.



Departure Day

Wednesday 19th February

· Children to be brought to school at normal time (8:45), wearing the clothes they are to wear for the rest of the day.

• Come into school via the Y3/4 doors into the Lower Hall - parents welcome to join us in the hall.

· On entering the hall, there will be a group table for each group. The children will have been told which group they are in prior to day.



- · At each table;
 - Collect the named luggage label which will need to be attached to your child's case / bag
 - Hand over any medication to the group leader all medication must be in a clearly named bag with dosage clearly labelled.
- •If your child has travel sickness pills, please ensure that they are given in advance of the outward journey and the group leader is given the return journey medication.



- Once checked in, parents are welcome to stay in the hall with their child.
- We will send the children for a toilet trip, in their groups, once we have registered everyone in.
- When the bus has arrived, children walk out entrance to meet the bus on Hawkeys Lane (outside of Aldi). Parents are welcome to walk up to the bus with the children to wave off.
- · Depart time approximately 9:30am.



Return Day

Friday 21st February - Return Journey

- · Final day of activities up until lunchtime.
- · Return time to school approximately 4pm
 - when group is en-route and an accurate time is known, a text will be sent out to parents
- Please come to Lower Key Stage 2 doors (Y3/4 yard) and you will be directed where to wait
- Upon arrival, ALL children will be brought into the lower hall where parents can collect.
- Please do not try and collect children straight from the coach
- Each group leader is responsible for ensuring their group go with their appropriate adult so please be patient as all medication needs to be returned.

· Arrive at school normal time and come in clothes wearing for rest of day

Make sure medication is labelled and handed over to group leader

· Check Instagram for any updates

· Wait for message for arrival time on Friday (Approx 4:00pm)

· Should there be any issues whilst we are away, please contact school.
