Literacy

Please continue to support your child at home learning their common words. These can be found in the back of their homework books. **Reading**: Reading sessions will continue to take place weekly and children will read with the teacher once across the week. Grammar: We will be concentrating on being consistent with a range of grammatical devices in our writing.

Writing: Firstly, we will recap key Y4 skills. Then, we will be creating a non-chronological report relating to the Romans. We will also be writing a calligram poem about electricity!
