Literacy

This term we will be writing a set of instructions and reading 'The Magic Paintbrush'.



ICT - An Introduction to Animation

We will learn to turn still frames into moving pictures by altering images and using a range of tools.



Science - Animals, including humans.

We will notice that animals have offspring which grow into adults.

We will find out about and describe the basic needs of animals for survival (water, food, air).

We will explore and compare the life cycles of different animals.



Maths - 2x and 10x tables

We will focus upon multiplication and division, counting in sets and sharing amounts. We will aim to develop quick recall of multiplication facts.




History - Remembrance

PE - Games
