This half term we will be writing a poem and a set of instructions all around the theme of colours.



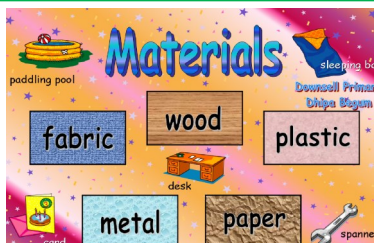
### ICT - Writing in Different Styles

### Music

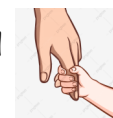
How Does Music Help Us to Make Friends?

We will learn how to be safe: at home, in school, when we're out & about and who we can turn to if we feel worried or unsure.



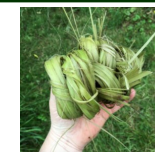
### PE - Health Related Fitness
