Literacy

Poetry - Sunny Spring

We will perform the poem 'Sunny Spring'.
We will explore alliteration and invent
our own springtime poems using present tense verbs.

Non-Fiction - Recounts

We will look at the features of recounts and write our own recounts of different events.

Remember to practise your spellings at home! You can find your spellings on the Year 1 page on our school website.

Science - Plants and Trees

We will name and identify some common flowering plants, including trees, and identify their basic structure.

We will notice the differences between Autumn, Winter and Spring.

PE - Gymnastics and Multi Skills

We will continue to develop our gymnastic skills to create a sequence of movements.

We will work on a variety of skills (e.g. ball control, running, throwing, jumping, skipping).



Music - Learning to Listen

We will explore how to listen with our eyes and ears and to also feel sound in our bodies. We will think about how music can help us to understand our neighbours.

Design & Technology - Making a Pencil Pot

We will design, make and evaluate a structure and explore how we can make it stronger, stiffer and more stable.



Geography - What is the weather like in the UK?

We will use maps and atlases to locate the four countries in the UK and identify the four compass directions. We will identify seasonal changes in the UK and daily weather patterns. We will understand how the weather changes with each season.

RE - The Easter Story

We will listen to The Easter Story and we will explore how and why Easter is celebrated by Christians.



ICT - Action Algorithms!

We will apply the concept of algorithms and instructions to a variety of contexts, both digital and analogue (e.g. recipes and dance routines).

PSHE - Who to Trust

We will recognise how we contribute to life in the classroom and around school.

We will discuss what helps and harms our locality.

We will recognise that we are all unique and we will know that we belong to different communities.

Maths

We will add and subtract numbers within 20. We will learn about and use number bonds to ten. We will double and halve numbers and use this knowledge to calculate near doubles and near halves. We will learn about and create our own number lines and use these to help us to add and to subtract within 20.
