Literacy:

The children will finish off writing their chronological reports based around the Island of Neverbelieve.

Macbeth

This unit of work involves drama and incorporates incidental writing, in the form of a persuasive letter and diary recount, based on the works of William Shakespeare.

Reading, grammar and spelling

Please continue to encourage your child to read daily. They also need to be practising their common word spellings that are given to them weekly.

PSHE—Relationships

This unit will focus on relationships. Children will identify who their VIPs are within their families and friendship groups and how important kindness and respect are within these relationships. The unit addresses conflicts and resolutions in relationships. The children will also look at the secrets and dares as well as healthy and unhealthy relationships.



Maths:

This half term the children will focus on statistics and algebra. They will look at data collection and how to reflect and make observations on the data given. In algebra, the children will start to use simple formulae, will describe number sequences using letters as symbols, and will find unknowns in an equation.

Art: Typography and Maps



The children will research and explore ideas of typography in Art.

PE—Basketball

The children will work with a coach to develop dribbling, throwing, catching and shooting skills, as well as working together as a team.



Science-Light - Let it Shine

The children will recognise that light appears to travel in straight



lines and use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye. They will also understand that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes. The units involves planning different types of scientific enquiries and controlling variables where necessary.

STEAM week!

The children will find out about the field of engineering. The children will be given the task of designing an innovative multi-purpose school outdoor structure that we could place on our school field. They will plan and design their idea and if chosen, will

get to 'pitch' their idea to our Science Panel!

RE—Why are Good Friday and Easter Monday the most important days for Christians?

The children will learn about what happened on Good Friday and why it is important to Christians. They will also learn about the relevance of Easter Sunday.

Science: light source, light ray, reflect, scatter, absorb, concave, convex, plane mirror, periscope RE—Easter, Christianity, Jesus, resurrection, crucifixion, burial, disciple and betrayal.

Literacy—sentence (simple, compound, complex), clause (main, subordinate, relative), noun, verb, adjective, preposition and determiner.
