Literacy

Fiction: We will explore the story 'Stone Age Boy'. The children will complete a range of reading, drama and writing activities linked to the story. Then, they will write a five part story based on our class text.

Non-Fiction: We will write a non-chronological report about 'The Stone Age'.

Poetry: We will explore a diamante poem about a caveman and then write our own poems.



History: Was Stone Age man a simple hunter-gatherer?

The children will learn about the earliest human civilisations and their way of life. They will explore how Stone Age people hunted and lived, as well as the tools they developed in order to survive.

Music

In Music, we will introduce the recorder and the notes B, A and G. The children will also enjoy singing our half-termly song - 'Let Your Spirit Fly'.



Pedestrian Training

We will take part in North Tyneside Council's pedestrian training course. The children will learn about road safety and the best places to cross the road. They will learn how to cross the road at different junctions and to be aware of different road users/traffic.

We will be looking at how working as a team has a positive impact on all of its members and what they can achieve.

Computing

We will explore Digital Literacy and Online Safety, covering topics such as: Privacy and Cyberbullying.

French

We will learn a range of French greetings!



Maths

In our first units of Maths, the children will continue to develop their understanding of 2 and 3 digit numbers. They will practise adding and subtracting using equipment as well as mental methods which focus on using a maths mastery approach.



Times Tables:

We will recap the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

Art: Gestural Drawing with Charcoal

The children will explore cave art and discover how to make drawings that capture a sense of drama or performance.

RE: Hinduism

In RE, we will be learning about the different ways in which Hindus worship.



PE: Health Related Fitness

In PE, the children will take part in high intensity circuits to develop their fitness levels.



Science: Rocks

Children will learn about the different properties of rocks and how to group them. They will recognise that soil comes from rocks and also learn how fossils are formed!
