

Funded Early Years Entitlements Chargeable Extras

Spring Gardens Primary School Nursery Provision

At Spring Gardens Primary School, we currently offer Nursery provision to 3 & 4 year olds. We offer a flexible provision to try and support parents childcare needs as best as possible.

We offer 15 hrs of childcare across AM or PM sessions and we offer up to 30hrs of childcare, where children attend for full days. We offer both funded and paid placements.

We currently offer a flexible arrangement where parents are able to send their pupils to Nursery for:

- AM sessions only
- PM sessions only
- All AM sessions plus some afternoon sessions
- All PM sessions plus some morning sessions
- Monday–Friday full days.

Pupils are required to attend for at least 15hrs in their AM or PM session.

From September 2026, we will also be offering 15hrs of Nursery provision to 2 year olds, offering both AM or PM sessions.

Charges

Additional hours

Parents who are not entitled to any additional hours outside of the universal 15hrs of funding, are welcome to pay for any additional hours. We ask that parents who would like this “Pay as you go” arrangement, agree to book in advance and book for at least 3 additional sessions. Parents are charged per session (AM/ PM).

The price of an AM or PM session is £17.50

Meals/ Snacks

Nursery pupils who are staying for full days are welcome to bring a packed lunch to school or parents are able to pay for school meals. Our school

meal provider is Hutchison and parents are set up with an account, where they can order meals in advance and pay via the app.

The cost of a school meal is £2.55.

Fruit is provided free of charge to all Nursery pupils as a snack, both in the morning and afternoon.

Consumables

Consumables in Nursery may include:

- Nappies
- Wipes
- Suncream

We do not charge for consumables, however parents are expected to provide these if required. School is not able to provide nappies, wipes or suncream.

Activities and trips

There may be times during the academic year when a trip or special activity is planned for Nursery pupils, which incurs a charge to school. In these cases, parent/carers may be asked for a voluntary contribution to help cover the cost of the trip/activity.
