Literacy

Fiction: We will explore an Egyptian myth - 'The Story of Isis and Osiris'. We will then rewrite it in our own words to form a five part story.



Non-Fiction: We will learn about the process of mummification and then write an explanation text about it.

Remember to complete your weekly reading homework as well as practising the spellings in the back of your homework book.

Art: Working with Shape and Colour

We will look closely at Egyptian artwork using the 'show me what you see' technique. We will look at how we can use shape and colour to simplify elements, inspired by the cut-outs of Henri Matisse.

Maths

In Maths, we will secure our knowledge of mental strategies for calculations up to 999. We will also learn the formal column method for addition and subtraction.

We will recap all of the times tables we have learnt so far, as well as beginning our 4x table!

ANCIENT EGYPT

PSHE: Aiming High

This unit focuses on goals and aspirations. We will learn about the importance of resilience and we will identify ways of applying a growth mindset to new challenges.

French

We will focus on naming different body parts as well as counting up to 31.

PE: Dodgeball

We will practise our throwing and catching skills during our dodgeball sessions.

History: Was there more to the Egyptians than the pyramids?

In our History lessons, the children will take part in a tomb excavation! They will explore how much they can learn about ancient Egypt from all of the artefacts left behind.

Computing: Animation with Scratch

We will be learning new animation skills and practising our coding using Scratch.

Science: Forces and Magnets

The children will be learning about push and pull forces and they will investigate materials that are magnetic and non-magnetic. They will understand how magnets attract and repel.
