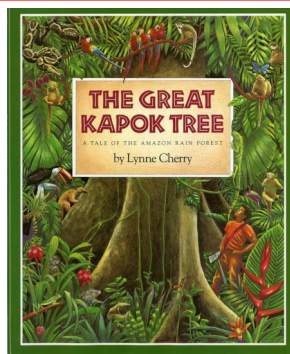
Term: Summer 2

Literacy

Fiction: We will explore the story - 'The Great Kapok Tree'. The children will complete a range of reading, drama and writing activities linked to the story. They will also write their own five part story based on our class text.

Poetry: We will enjoy exploring haikus!



Geography: Why are rainforests important to us?

We will explore the Amazon Rainforest and learn about the different layers of a tropical rainforest. We will understand the term 'indigenous' and explore how indigenous people use the Amazon's resources. Finally, we will discuss our local woodland and understand how it is used.

Design and Technology: British Inventors

In DT, we will be learning about key events and designs that have shaped the world.



PSHE: Britain



This unit is inspired by the idea that we live in a diverse, multicultural and democratic society. The children will learn about British people, rules, the law, liberty and what living in a democracy means. They will also learn the importance of being tolerant of differences within their society.

RE: Hinduism - What do Hindus believe?

We will learn about Hindu Gods / Goddesses and the impact of their beliefs.



Computing: Kodu

The children will be introduced to creating games with Kodu. They will have a go at programming characters, designing 3D worlds and making exciting collecting and racing games.

Maths

We will begin the half term by learning about non-unit fractions. Then, we will look at telling the time. We will also explore parallel and perpendicular sides in polygons. We will end the year with statistics.

French

We will continue learning about animals in French this half term.



Music

We will continue to play the recorder and we will consolidate our learning from across the year.
